



Agrifoods business prepares for big mungbean season

Family owned Agrifoods Australia recently achieved an internationally-recognised Quality Assurance (QA) accreditation and a national HACCP food safety warranty, and has plans in place to install a new robot in the plant this month.

Owner Rob Anderson said having been recognised with a ISO9001-2008 Quality Assurance standard had given the business more credibility on the world stage.

“It gives our growers and customers added peace-of-mind that they are working with a business that meets the strictest service and quality standards.

“The QA standard builds on the systems we already had in place, by forcing us to be even more pedantic about our record keeping and product specifications. Our traceability was good before but now it’s exceptional.”

He said achieving the quality certification was a credit to his team.

“We set a target to achieve this certification as part of our five year strategic plan, and we actually did it in two years. I can’t thank my team enough for their commitment to getting this in place.

“The more we dug into it the more we uncovered the advantages it gives us as a business.”

A silo capacity of around 4,000 metric tonnes and a number of upgrades to the processing plant over the past few years, has Agrifoods Australia well positioned to continue to be a strong force in the Pulse, Birdseed and Specialty Markets.
